

CROCKETT IS OUR HOME

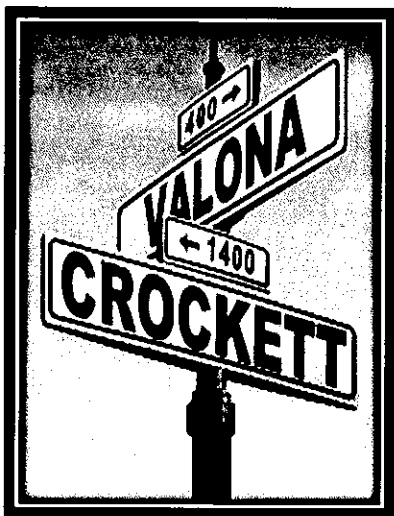
